



PLANNED ABSENCE ADVANCE NOTIFICATION

With the understanding that this planned absence is parent initiated, any student in grades 7–12 may request this form. This form is to be filled-out in order. Step A indicates that this is a parent initiated notification. Step B assures teachers that the school administration is aware of the planned absence. Step C gives teachers the opportunity to inform the parent and student what will be missed and what will be expected of him/her before and/or after the absence. Step D indicated that the parent understands and accepts the conditions/consequences of the absence. Step E provides final confirmation to the school of the planned absence and that all parties have been properly informed. Once receiving the final administrative signature, the student retains this form as a record of the teachers' expectations and/or assignments.

Directions: Complete each section IN SEQUENCE. You will not be able to get the necessary signatures unless the previous section has been completed. This completed form is to be submitted to the High School Office no later than 3:00PM, two calendar days before the Planned Absence.
